KDOT to host NEPA Environmental Assessment public open house for K-92 Centennial bridge replacement project on August 29

The Kansas Department of Transportation (KDGT), in coordination with the Missouri Department of Transportation (MoDOT), is hosting an Environmental Assessment (EA) public open house for the K-92 Centennial Bridge replacement project on Tuesday, August 29. The public is invited to attend the informal meeting anytime between **5 p.m. and 7 p.m. at the Riverfront Community Center, 123 S. Esplanade Street, Leavenworth, Kansas 66048.**


As part of the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA), the EA open house will give attendees the opportunity to speak with project representatives, understand the outcomes of past environmental studies conducted by KDGT and MoDOT, view preliminary designs and anticipated schedule for the new bridge, and understand the purpose and need for a new bridge. There will not be a formal presentation.

Replacement of the existing bridge is necessary as the structure is nearing the end of its useful life and major repairs to the steel structure will become more numerous and expensive over time. The project is expected to begin in 2026 and be completed in 2029.
